

ALASKA ASSOCIATION FOR CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

CONSTITUTION Adopted November 19, 2004

Article I ~ Name

The name of this organization shall be the ALASKA ASSOCIATION FOR CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION, hereinafter referred to as AACTE. This organization declares its relation to the Association for Career and Technical Education as an affiliated state association.

Article II ~ Goals

The goals of the AACTE shall be to promote and improve the cause of Career and Technical Education to the state of Alaska and to render service to its members.

Article III ~ Members

Section 1

To be eligible for membership in the AACTE, a person shall be engaged or interested in Career and Technical Education work of a professional nature and/or hold a Career and Technical Education teaching certificate.

Section 2

All members shall have the right to vote and hold office in the AACTE.

Article IV ~ Affiliated Sections

Section 1

A Section shall consist of a group of AACTE members engaged in a specific instructional or service area of Career and Technical Education.

Article V ~ Officers

The officers of the AACTE shall be the President, President Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, and Past President.

Article VI ~ Parliamentary Authority

Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised shall govern the proceedings of the AACTE.

Article VII ~ Amendments

This Constitution may be amended at any annual meeting of the association by a two-thirds vote, provided that the text of the proposed amendment(s) shall have been published in an official publication of the AACTE, and/or sent to all the membership at least thirty (30) days prior to the annual meeting .

Article VIII ~ By-Laws

By-laws consistent with the constitution shall be adopted by the total membership of the association with a two-thirds vote of all members present and voting required for approval. Adoption may also be ratified by a mail ballot following presentation of proposed by-laws at the annual meeting.
